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## 08 Residential Microtopping & Resurfacing

Thin resurfacing for worn patios, garage slabs, basement floors, and residential concrete updates.

### WHAT IT IS

Residential microtopping adds a thin cementitious finish layer when concrete is worn, patched, stained, or visually inconsistent but still worth restoring.

### HOW IT'S DONE

- Prepare the slab, repair defects, profile the surface, and prime for the selected resurfacing system.
- Apply thin troweled or squeegeed layers with a homeowner-approved sample or mock up when finish expectations matter.
- Seal or protect the resurfaced concrete based on traffic, cleaning, weather exposure, and final appearance.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

Microtopping has natural hand-finished variation. Surflex discusses color, texture, sealer, and maintenance expectations before full placement.
