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05 Crack & Joint Repair

Clean crack, control-joint, expansion-joint, and gap repairs before coating, polishing, or continued use.

WHAT IT IS

Crack and joint repair closes floor and wall defects so surfaces can function better and receive a cleaner final finish.

HOW IT'S DONE

- Identify the type of crack or joint, movement potential, edge condition, and final surface requirement.
- Route, clean, vacuum, and prepare the repair area before placing epoxy, polyurethane, polyurea, joint filler, or sealant.
- Finish flush or tooled as required for polishing, coating, sealing, traffic, or continued facility use.

WHAT TO EXPECT

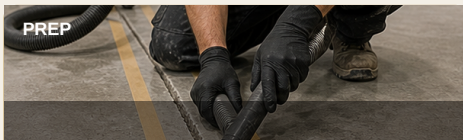
Repairs may require cleaning, routing, filling, curing, and shaving or finishing. Surflex keeps the work staged and communicates what can reopen when.
