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01 Residential Mechanical Polishing

WHAT IT IS

Residential mechanical polishing refines existing concrete into a smoother, cleaner, lower-maintenance surface without making the home feel like a commercial jobsite.

HOW IT'S DONE

- Review the slab, protect walls, doors, trim, stored items, and nearby finished surfaces before equipment starts.
- Use compact grinding and polishing equipment with dust collection, progressive tooling, and densifier or guard when appropriate.
- Confirm the target sheen and exposure with the homeowner so the finished floor matches the expected use and appearance.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Most projects include noise, equipment movement, and controlled dust collection. Surfex plans access, cleanup, and phasing around occupied homes whenever practical.
