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06 Residential Concrete Patching & Wall Repair

Basement wall repairs, garage stem-wall patching, spalls, pipe penetrations, and damaged concrete details.

WHAT IT IS

Residential concrete patching rebuilds damaged concrete around basement walls, utility spaces, garage edges, porch details, pipe penetrations, and small slab defects.

HOW IT'S DONE

- Remove loose or unsound concrete, clean the repair area, and choose hydraulic grout, patching mortar, epoxy mortar, or cementitious repair material.
- Pack, inject, or trowel repair material into prepared cracks, voids, penetrations, spalls, and edges.
- Finish the repair for service, sealing, coating, waterproofing, or continued residential use.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Repair work may involve moisture, dust, scraping, curing time, and access to tight utility areas. Surflex protects equipment and household storage.

Loose material is removed and the repair area is cleaned and protected.

INSTALL



Hydraulic grout, patching mortar, or epoxy mortar is placed into prepared concrete.

HANDOFF



The repaired area is cleaned and readied for service, sealing, coating, or protection.
