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08 Microtopping & Resurfacing

Thin cementitious resurfacing for worn, stained, patched, or visually inconsistent concrete.

WHAT IT IS

Microtopping adds a thin finish layer when concrete has been repaired or corrected but still needs a more uniform surface.

HOW IT'S DONE

- Prepare the existing concrete, repair defects, and prime the surface for the selected cementitious topping.
- Apply thin troweled or squeegeed layers, refine the surface, and protect the finish during cure.
- Seal or coat the resurfaced floor based on traffic, appearance, maintenance, and exposure requirements.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Mock ups are especially useful for microtopping because color, texture, movement, and hand finish can vary by slab and installation method.

FINAL RESULTS

A renewed surface with a cleaner, more consistent appearance that can be sealed or coated for the customer's intended use.
